


SAVE A FAMILY PLAN

About Us

Save A Family Plan (SAFP) partners together with impoverished families throughout India living in conditions of extreme poverty. Since 1965, our international organization has been striving toward social justice and change, enabling people to create better futures for themselves, their families, and their communities.

Our on-the-ground staff work directly with all people irrespective of their caste, creed, gender or political affiliation.

In collaboration with local resources and officials, our needs-based programming provides a holistic service approach. Our teams in Canada and India design, fund and deliver a variety of programs that identify and meet local needs.

Participants for these programs are chosen based on criteria such as poverty, serious illness, lack of housing, and so on. They are truly the "poorest of the poor."

Our programs change over time depending on need, and are made possible thanks to the generous financial support of our donors and grantors. Generally, our programs fall within two main categories:

Family Development Program

This is our core program, the six-year-long "plan" in which donors pledge \$25 per month to their partner family in India. These families meet with our local field staff to work together to identify practicable, sustainable ways to improve their overall well-being and overcome dire circumstances.

Some methods include: income generation through small business initiatives, creating a family bank account, nutrition assistance, child and maternal health improvement, and ways to seek local opportunities for medical care and education. Our staff also provide personal support and compassion.



Community Development Program



Our community-focused programs help villages to work together to identify their greatest needs, address poverty-related struggles, and thrive. Thanks to funding from Save A Family Plan donors, together with citizen involvement and local supports, projects are undertaken to make vital improvements in areas such as clean water and sanitation. We also offer training and educational programs, natural disaster rehabilitation, and housing construction. Some recent special projects including pandemic recovery aid and leprosy rehabilitation. Participants are involved throughout every step.
