Indian states where SAFP operates

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KERALA

Kerala is known for beautiful green landscapes and backwaters - an intricate system of lagoons, canals, lakes, and inlets spanning over 900 km.

Additionally, it is famous for the spice trade and Kathakali dance. Kerala is also home to the oldest European-style church in India, St. Francis Church in Kochi.

SAFP's work in Kerala focuses on various programs to enhance the quality of life in Kerala: poverty support programs, women-led support groups, sustainable agriculture, livelihood programs, and housing construction.

TAMIL NADU

Tamil Nadu is home to 33,000 temples across the state. The state is famous for the Dravidian architecture and is the home of Bharatanatyam (also previously called Sadhir Attam), one of the oldest classical forms of dance.

Tamil is the most common language spoken in this state and is one of the longest-surviving classical languages in the world.

In Thanjavur, the Brihadeeswarar Temple has a dome that weighs 80 tons, incredibly lifted into place without any modern machinery.

KARNATAKA

Karnataka is home to some of the world's leading I.T. companies, with Bangalore as India's "tech capital." Karnataka is also India's leading coffee producer and boasts incredible biodiversity, including Bandipur National Park. It

is also home to the ancient ruins of Hampi.

Save A Family Plan's work in Karnataka includes educational initiatives, financial literacy training, the Women's Empowerment Program, and housing construction.

MAHARASHTRA

Maharashtra is India's economic powerhouse and its famous "Bollywood" film industry is both India's and the world's largest movie producer.

Maharashtra boasts incredible natural beauty, featuring the Ajanta and Ellora caves. Interesting fact: a company in Mumbai delivers 200,000 lunchboxes daily with an almost perfect accuracy rate—without using modern technology!

SAFP's work in Maharashtra includes clean water initiatives, health and hygiene training, and sanitary toilet construction.

TELENGANA
